Happy New Year and Happy 60th Birthday DW

2008 is going to be a great year, not least because Devizes Westminster is celebrating its 60th anniversary. Sixty years since that first gauntlet to travel to London by canoe was first thrown down. We're hoping the 2008 event will be as successful as ever. We've got a number of exciting plans in the pipeline and we'll send news about them in the coming weeks and months.

If you're paddling, hopefully the training is in full swing, injury free and going smoothly. Entry Forms now Online

While we're proud to celebrate 60 years of DW history, we are also pleased to announce a small step into the future with the introduction of online entries. The form is simple to use and paddlers may either pay online through Paypal or send a cheque in the traditional way. We hope this innovation will make life just that little bit easier for paddlers and organisers alike. One thing to note - because the form will be filled in by only one person on behalf of any crew, we will require all paddlers to sign up to the standard Limitation of Liability when checking in at Devizes. Lighting on the Tideway for 4 day Racers

We'd like to remind entrants to the 4 day events that the early tide time on the Monday will mean that all boats will need to carry appropriate lights. These must be produced for inspection at Devizes, though they need not be carried till the Monday. For full details of lighting rules, see the appropriate class rules on the website.

We need about 300 volunteers to make DW work, and we need a constant supply of new recruits to learn the skills required and replace some of the old hands who are looking to retire their Easter.
